

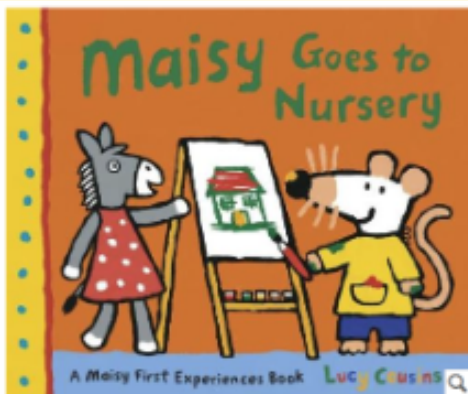


There are lots of books that can help parents/carers to talk to children about starting nursery or playgroup.

Have a look for some of these books in the library or bookshop. You might also find some in a second-hand shop or online.

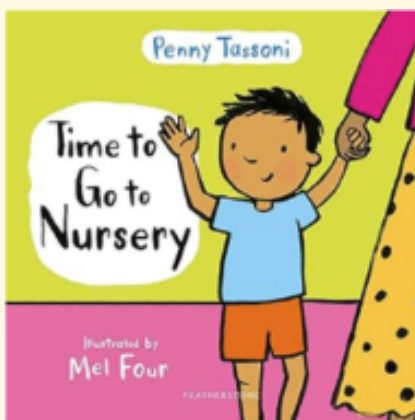


## Books to help prepare for starting a new setting

This book reassures children that there are new, fun things to try at pre-school and new friends to meet.

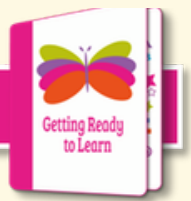


### **Time to Go to Nursery by Penny Tassoni**

This book explains what a day in nursery will be like with some of the exciting activities on offer.

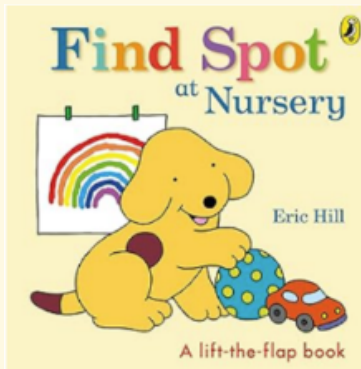


All phones away

Spot is starting his first day at nursery school. He meets new friends, finds out where to hang his coat and tries new things before Mum comes to pick him up at the end of the day.



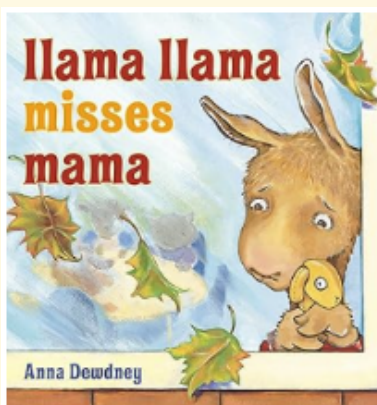
## Find Spot at Nursery by Eric Hill
