

# Make a Christmas Garland!



This garland is fun, easy to make, and is a memento of your child that you can treasure forever!

## Supplies:

- \* Pen
- \* One side of a cereal box.
- \* 6-8 sheets of card painted or coloured in different shades of green. 1 sheet of card coloured red.
- \* Scissors
- \* Glue
- \* Large round plate
- \* Small round bowl.
- \* Ribbon.
- \* A penny

**Step 1**– Trace your child’s hand onto the side of the cereal box to make a template and cut it out.

**Step 2**– Take one of the green pieces of card and place your plate onto it. Trace around it to make the circle for your garland

**Step 3**–Place the bowl in the centre of the circle and draw around it.

**Step 4**–Cut out your circles

**Step 5**–Using your child’s hand template, trace and cut about 20-25 hands out of the remaining green card. Help your child to stick them on to the garland.

**Step 6**–place the penny onto the red card and draw around it to create berries. Cut them out and stick them to the garland.

**Step 7**–Tie your ribbon to your garland and hang it up!
