## Painting Pumpkins!

Carving pumpkins can be hard for little hands, so why not have your child paint their pumpkin instead? They can also use glue and glitter to make it extra spooky!

## Halloween Bottle Ornaments!

Children can practice sorting with this fun, no mess idea. Draw ghost and Jack O' Lantern faces on empty plastic bottles. Place white, orange, black and green painted cotton balls on a plate and let your child fill each bottle with the correct colour.

## Playdough Halloween Monsters!

Set out different playdough colours and an array of decorations such as glitter, pipe cleaners, buttons, pom poms etc. Then see what spooky creatures emerge from your child's imagination!

## Leaf Ghosts!

Take your little one on a nature walk to gather leaves. Once you are back home, paint the leaves white together and add eyes with black marker. You can then thread them together with string and make a spooky ghost garland!

## Handprint Spiders!

Let your child paint their hands and then press them onto paper to make spider shapes. Then add googly eyes to make creepy spiders!

## Toilet Roll Mummies

Paint toilet roll tubes black. Add some googly eyes. Wrap the toilet paper tubes with stripes of gauze, making sure to glue it in place, until all of your mummy is covered and only it's eyes are peeking out!
